For Class Size Reduction

Lower student-teacher ratios make a big difference in the classroom. It allows teachers to build deeper, more meaningful relationships with the students, differentiate instruction, and have quality interactions with the students. It creates a more powerful learning environment.

The DVMS Foundation has existed since the school opened and focuses on reducing class sizes in **Math**, **Science**, and **Core** for <u>all</u> grade levels. We are a parent-run, nonprofit organization affiliated with the San Ramon Valley Education Foundation (SRVEF). Our 501(c)3 designation gives our donors the opportunity for the maximum deduction allowed under the current laws and corporate match benefits.

For the 2021-2022 school year, we are committed to funding 8 additional classes, which will cost \$162,728.






